


I. Purpose

To obtain Real Estate Committee and Board approval of Arlington County's request to allocate an additional \$624,851 in TIIF funds to support continued work on the Ballston-MU Metrorail Station Access Improvement Project




II. Background

- By letter dated October 13, 2005, Arlington County requested WMATA Board approval to allocate an additional \$624,851 in TIIF funds to support continued work on the Ballston-MU Metrorail station Access Improvement Project
- Ballston-MU Metrorail station west entrance improvements include new escalators and stair, two new elevators, new mezzanine and stairs and a pedestrian tunnel from the escalator and stairs to the existing station
- This action will increase the project's funding up to the Board approved budget of \$16 million
- Arlington County has \$3,371,045 in accumulated TIIF revenue out of the first \$60 million of TIIF collection. Of that \$3,371,045, \$2,250,000 has been committed to County projects, leaving \$1,121,045 available for other uses.




Ballston-MU Station West Entrance

NARRATIVE

Arlington County has requested that \$624,851 of its share of the Transit Infrastructure Investment Fund (TIIF) be allocated to fund continued work on the Ballston-MU Metrorail Station Access Improvement Project. This will fund the project up to its current Arlington County and WMATA Board approved budget of \$16,000,000. The County has accumulated \$3,371,045 in TIIF revenue of which \$2,250,000 has been obligated for projects under contract leaving \$1,121,045 in unreserved TIIF revenue available.

ALTERNATIVE:

Do not approve the requested allocation of \$624,851. This would prevent the Ballston-MU station west entrance improvements from advancing with this funding.

IMPACT ON FUNDING:

Arlington County has \$1,121,045 in unreserved TIIF revenue. If the request for \$624,851 is approved by the Board, the County will have \$496,194 remaining in its TIIF allocation. All obligations will be reported in the TIIF Quarterly Report.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Real Estate Committee and the Board of Directors authorize the allocation of \$624,851 from the TIIF for the reimbursable capital project to improve access at the Ballston-MU Metrorail station.
