### **PURPOSE**

To obtain Board approval to:

- 1. Establish a project for the replacement of the Southeastern Bus Garage;
- 2. Establish a \$500,000 budget for a feasibility study and early actions and increase the FY07 SAP from \$64,837,000 to \$65,337,000; and
- 3. Authorize a task to the on-call consultant for the study.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

To support the redevelopment of the Anacostia waterfront and to provide a modern Metrobus maintenance facility, staff is recommending a new project, "Replacement of Southeastern Bus Garage". The District of Columbia in coordination with WMATA, has considered alternative replacement sites and has identified its preferred site within D.C. Village. Staff seeks funding of a three-month feasibility study for this site and of early actions for the replacement. The study includes development of an interim facility at the site for an early relocation. The budget for the feasibility study and early actions is \$500,000. The funding source for the budget is the sale proceeds of the WMATA employee parking lot of the Southeastern Bus Garage, as authorized by Board action on October 19, 2006. Staff will return to the Budget Committee and Board with the results of the study and with a request for a budget amendment for the funding of project development.

WHEREAS, On January 19, 2006, the Board of Directors adopted the Southeastern Bus Garage as a first priority project for relocation and directed staff to explore all reasonable alternatives in preparing a plan to accomplish the relocation, subject to the availability of funding and jurisdictional coordination and endorsement; and

WHEREAS, On October 19, 2006, the Board of Directors authorized the execution of a Sales and Development Agreement for the Navy Yard Station (West Entrance) and an adjacent lot for WMATA employee parking and authorized the net proceeds of the sale of the lot to be applied to the cost of the replacement of the Southeastern Bus Garage; and

WHEREAS, On January 25, 2007, the Board of Directors amended the Fiscal Year 2007 System Access/Capacity Program (SAP) totaling \$64,837,000; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors amends and increases the Fiscal Year 2007 SAP by \$500,000 from \$64,837,000 to \$65,337,000, as reflected on Attachment A, to fund a feasibility study and early actions for the replacement of the Southeastern Bus Garage, with funding coming from the net proceeds of the sale of the WMATA employee parking lot at the Southeastern Bus Garage; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
