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NARRATIVE

DISCUSSION:

WMATA requires retaining specialized labor legal counsel and representational services in connection with reviewing, analyzing and advocating WMATA's interests in collective bargaining and labor/management relations for a three (3) year base period and two (2) one-year options subject to sufficient funds in the budget.

During FY 2007, these professional legal services will be necessary to assist in concluding negotiations and/or implementing contract modifications with Local 689 ATU, Local 2 OPEIU, L922 IBT, L639 IBT and the FOP, as well as their respective New Service Agreements. Given the heavy emphasis in bargaining on health, welfare and pension cost containment measures, specialized legal counsel is vital to WMATA in formulating its negotiating and arbitration strategies. Specialized legal expertise is also needed to assist in the preparation of supporting arguments, testimony and exhibit presentations for any contingent interest arbitrations resulting from contract negotiations and/or disputes with WMATA's five (5) labor unions representing approximately eighty-five percent (85%) of the Authority's workforce. Further, these services are required to assist in analyzing other continuing cost containment issues and may be required to provide legal advice on judicial and arbitral decisions, grievance arbitrations, Urban Mass Transportation Act 13 (c) agreements, ADA, pension law and other ad hoc assignments relating to WMATA's labor relations.

It is the intent of the Authority to initiate a new contract using WMATA's competitive procurement process. Firms that submit proposals will be evaluated by a Source Selection Evaluation Board in accordance with WMATA's procurement regulations.
