

Background



- The West Ox Complex is a partnership between Fairfax County and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority.
- Facility encompasses approximately 130 acres of which 33 acres are dedicated to West Ox bus facility located on West Ox Road between Route 29 and Route 88.
- Facility will provide critical infrastructure to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of transportation services in the County and Northern Virginia.



- Nine maintenance bays dedicated to WMATA
 - o Two with parallelogram lifts
 - o One with wheel lift
 - o One flat inspection bay
 - o Five bays with in-ground twin post lifts

- Public Safety and Transportation Operations Center will include:
 - o Fairfax County Department of Public Safety Communication 9-1-1 Call Center
 - o Fairfax County Office of Emergency Management
 - o Virginia State Police Division 7 call-takers and dispatchers
 - o Virginia Department of Transportation Smart Traffic Center

Financial Impact

Metro Matters Budget:

\$34,485,000

- Designed, constructed and owned by Fairfax County
- Joint use agreement with Fairfax County 75 year lease
- WMATA will share annual facility operating costs, such as utilities, trash, etc.
- WMATA will share the cost of infrastructure renewal
