Elimination of Route N22 would amend the Metrobus subsidy by \$401,000 in FY09 and by \$1,604,000 annually.

Action Items

A. Authorization to Conduct Public Hearings on Mechanisms to Fill FY2010 Budget Gap

Staff requested that the Board's Finance, Oversight and Administration Committee authorize Metro to conduct public hearings on bus service reductions. Two Resolutions were proposed by the Committee.
