### **NARRATIVE**

### **DISCUSSION:**

The contract for Steel Tunnel Liner Rehabilition (FN5012) was awarded in February 2005, in the amount of \$3,958,179.30. This contract provides for the repair of the steel liner assembly which has deteriorated due to corrosion between L'Enfant Plaza and Waterfront Stations on the Green Line. The rehabilitation will lengthen the service life of the tunnels and minimize costly remediation efforts.

The quantity for contract bid item no. 6 "Stop leaks by repairing/replacing caulking between ribs at leak locations" must be increased to satisfactorily complete the rehabilitation. The additional quantity has been estimated based upon the observations of the work performed by the contractor to date, in areas representative of all conditions.

Bid item no. 6 is now estimated to be about 55,000 LF, this represents an increase of approximately 35,000 LF of caulking. The original survey was conducted in 2004 to identify all leaking joints and estimate leak repair lengths. During contract implementation actual conditions require additional caulking to satisfactorily seal all leaks. Additional funding is based on estimated quantity increases.

Board approval of this increase in quantity is required since the value of the work exceeds 10% of the award.
