PURPOSE

The purpose of this action is to request Committee and Board of Directors approval of a resolution to increase the FY07 System Expansion Program (SEP) by \$2,340,000, from \$7,614,000 to \$9,954,000 for Largo Extension litigation costs. This action will also increase the overall budget for Largo from \$457,050,000 to \$459,390,000.

DESCRIPTION

There is a \$32 million claim on the Largo Extension project and the litigation is before the Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals. The claim is being litigated by outside counsel and because the original contract work was performed pursuant to a reimbursable agreement, Maryland is funding the litigation costs. The funds have been received and placed into the Largo account. Board of Directors approval is needed to amend and increase the SEP so that work may continue on the claim.
