Background:

(I) Architectural and Engineering Services Contract (SF5070)

- This is the second year of a five (5) year contract awarded on June 20, 2005 for "On-Call" General Architectural and Engineering Services to P2D, a joint venture consisting of Parsons Transportation Group, Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, and Delon Hampton and Associates.
- The estimated cost for the FY 07 annual work program is \$24,028,000.

(2) Vehicle Engineering Consultant Services Contracts (FG1451)

- In order to provide continuity of services for on-going major vehicle programs, the Vehicle Engineering Contract FG1451 with Booz Allen Hamilton was extended through December 2007.
- The estimated cost for the FY07 program is \$11,400,000.

(3) Vehicle Engineering Consultant Services Contracts (C05102)

- This is the first, of four, one-year options for professional engineering and technical services with Booz Allen Hamilton in support of future vehicle programs.
- Estimated costs for the FY 07 program is \$2,850,000.

(4) Planning, Architectural, and Engineering Services for Future 'New Starts' Projects Contract (SF5111)

- This is the second year of a five year contract awarded on September 2005 for "On-Call" Planning, Architectural, and Engineering Services for future 'New Starts' Projects to DMJM Harris, Inc.
- The estimated cost of FY 07 annual work program is \$1,484,000.

NARRATIVE

DISCUSSION:
