Action Items

A. FY2010 MetroAccess Program Review

Staff provided the Committee with a review of current MetroAccess economic factors, a comparison of current service parameters as compared to ADA baseline requirements and a summation of the recently conducted 2009 APTA Peer Review. In addition, staff requested \$6.5 million in additional contracting authority for the paratransit contract through the end of FY2009.

Mr. Solomon moved approval, Mr. Linton seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved.

B. Capital Budget Amendment for the Anacostia Light Rail Reimbursable Project

The route for this reimbursable project for the development of a streetcar project east of the Anacostia River was revised which delayed the line, station and facility construction, resulting in additional costs associated with storage of equipment, and funding for Metro support staff and vehicle engineering consultants. Consequently, staff requested approval to increase the project budget for the District of Columbia Anacostia Light Rail Project by \$860,000, from \$16,100,000 to \$16,960,000. Funding is available from accrued interest on monies already held on account for this project.

Mr. Graham moved approval, Mr. Giancola seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved.
