PURPOSE

To request Board approval for a one-year base procurement (FY08) with four one-year options (FY09-12) for organizational development initiatives not previously approved.

DESCRIPTION

The Authority has ongoing professional requirements during FY08-12 in the areas of organizational and executive development. These complex, and often long-term, initiatives require knowledgeable professionals who can assess, evaluate, recommend and implement actions in areas such as organizational analysis, the increase of workflow effectiveness, the enhancement of worker/team effectiveness, advanced process design, and group conflict resolution. Executive coaching is also a component of the Authority's overall executive development process that seeks to support identified future leaders through face-to-face coaching with certified professionals in the field. The need for discreet specialists with impeccable qualifications and expediency in this vast field is evident; this project seeks to pre-select a range of consultancies to perform this work on an as-needed basis.
