## **PURPOSE**

To request Board approval to initiate and award a competitive requirements contract with a two-year base and three one-year options for the procurement of various Cummins engine components and parts required for bus maintenance and stock replenishment.

## **DESCRIPTION**

Cummins engine parts are required to support fleet maintenance requirements of the Bus Maintenance Department. These parts are used to replace worn, defective, or inoperative parts during the various maintenance and repair activities at bus shops and garages. Solicitation of this long-term requirements contract was necessitated by the termination of contract YR4094 with Weber White for Cummins engine parts due to the vendor's going out of business. The establishment of a new requirements contract will help ensure that adequate supplies are readily available to support revenue vehicles.
