




PURPOSE

COLUMBUS DAY

- Service Disruptions Friday, 9:30 PM on October 9th Tuesday, 5 AM on October 13th
 - Waterfront-SEU and Archives-Navy Memorial-Penn Quarter stations CLOSED
 - No Green or Yellow line service at L'Enfant Plaza

What will be Accomplished

- Replacement of switches These replacements were recommended by the NTSB and will provide the customers with fewer delays and a smoother ride.
- Annual Yellow Line bridge inspection and maintenance
- Track Fastener Maintenance & Replacement Work
- Tunnel Lighting Repairs

Customer Outreach

- Press releases, local media outreach
- Metro website
- Customer service personnel (staff) will be placed the following stations: Gallery Place/Chinatown, L'Enfant Plaza, Navy Yard and Pentagon this includes staffing the platforms in addition to the entrances
- Additional signage will be placed at Archives and Waterfront to direct customers to the nearest stations, which are only a few blocks away.
- Take ones Will be on hand in the stations and also provided to the customer service personnel for distribution.



PROJECTS WITH CUSTOMER IMPACT REQUIRING TRACK OUTAGES

Single Tracking Operations

- There will be several single tracking operations scheduled for the remainder of the year. This list is in the appendix.
- Customers will be notified through the Metro Website, Passenger Information Display System (PIDS), announcements in the system, and press releases.

PROJECTS WITH CUSTOMER IMPACT

September – November, Addison Road Parking Garage

- Completion of minor construction items in the garage may impact some parking spaces
- Customer Outreach: Signage, Metro website

Weekends in October, New Carrollton Parking Lots

- Park-and-Ride and Kiss-and-Ride Lots will have minor detours for milling and paving work
- Customer Outreach: Signage, Metro Website

October - Metro Center Sales Office

- Sales office demolition and reconstruction will limit access and may create some disruption of sales
- Customer Outreach: News release, signage, Metro Website

PROJECTS WITH CUSTOMER IMPACT

October - December, West Falls Church Metrorail Station

- North side bus bays will have pedestrian detours for canopy installation
- Customer Outreach: Signage, Metro Website

October – December, Elevator and Escalator Rehabilitation

- Rehabilitation of Elevators and Escalators in the Metrorail system.
- Customer Outreach: Signage, Metro Website, PIDS, train announcements

October – June 2011, Franconia- Springfield Parking Garage

- Major rehabilitation, as part of standard life cycle parking garage maintenance.
- Up to 5% of the parking spaces will be unavailable each day. Utilization rate is 94%.
