WHEREAS, As part of the procurement of the Metro Matters expansion of the Brentwood, Greenbelt and Shady Grove Yards, WMATA solicited independent proposals for the expansion of the Alexandria Yard; and

WHEREAS, The RFP allowed that the Alexandria Shop expansion option can be exercised within 270 calendar days of the award of the Metro Matters yards expansion contracts or by April 22, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Staff is also seeking approval under a separate Resolution to hold a WMATA Compact public hearing to receive and consider comments from the public on the General Plans for the Alexandria Shop expansion; and

WHEREAS, The Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation has committed \$200,000 to WMATA to conduct an environmental review of expanding the Alexandria Shop to improve operations and maintenance of Metrorail in Virginia; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors approves adding the Alexandria Shop expansion project to the SAP as a reimbursable project and amending and increasing the Fiscal 2006 SAP by \$200,000 from \$12,350,000 to \$12,550,000; and be it finally

NARRATIVE

DISCUSSION:

As a part of the procurement of the Metro Matters Yard expansions of the Brentwood, Greenbelt, and Shady Grove Shops that was awarded as two contracts in August 2005, the Offices of Construction and Procurement solicited proposals for the modification of the Alexandria Yard. The unfunded option for the modification of the Alexandria Yard was evaluated as a part of the Greenbelt Yard and Shady Grove Yard contract. Expanding the yard at this site allows for the increased rail car maintenance capacity to facilitate use of 8-car consists.

The proposed project includes addition of twelve maintenance bays, extension of the blow pit, modification of the tracks to accommodate the new maintenance bays, and addition of employee parking.

The procurement allowed that the Alexandria S&I Yard Modification option must be exercised within 270 calendar days of the award of the Greenbelt / Shady Grove Project, which was awarded on July 26, 2005. Therefore, for the proposed price of \$35,535,000 for the Alexandria Shop Expansion to be held, the option must be exercised by April 22, 2006.

The Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) has committed \$200,000 and has requested WMATA initiate a WMATA Compact public hearing and an environmental review to support the proposed modifications to the Alexandria Yard.

Staff hereby seeks the approval of the Board to:

- (1) Hold a WMATA Compact public hearing to receive and consider comments, suggestions and alternatives from the public on the General Plans and environmental evaluation for the Alexandria S&I Yard Modification;
- (2)Issue a task not to exceed \$200,000 under contract SF5111 for Planning, Architectural and Engineering Services for Future New Starts Projects to perform the environmental review, subject to the receipt of funds from DRPT;
- (3) Authorize the General Manager/CEO to release for public review the Public Hearing Staff Report for public review, as soon as the report is available; and
- (4) Authorize staff to establish a Reimbursable Project in the FY06 System Access/Capacity Program (SAP) with funding to be provided by DRPT, to amend the FY06 SAP budget by \$200,000 for this project, and to negotiate and execute a reimbursable project agreement with DRPT.

After the public hearing, Staff will prepare the Public Hearing Staff Report with necessary supplemental information to incorporate public comments, address the comments with staff's responses and make final recommendations to the Board.

ALTERNATIVE:

- (1) Do not approve the holding of WMATA Compact public hearing. This will result in expiration of the option. Should the Board desire to obtain authorize the yard modification, a new solicitation would be required.
- (2) Do not approve the issuance of a task for consulting services. This will result in the delay of the assessment of the environmental impacts, and likely expiration of the option.
- (3) If actions (1) and (2) are not approved then action (3) will not be possible. There is insufficient time to return to the Board for subsequent authorization to release the Staff Report, AND exercising the option in a timely manner. The option will expire.
- (4) Without an executed agreement for a reimbursable project with DRPT or an authorized budget, there will be no funds available to perform this work.
