Metro Channel and Email Migration Support

PURPOSE:

To obtain Board approval to initiate and award a competitive procurement for Novell eDirectory Sunset Project Analysts and to exercise options on existing contracts for consultant services, to create, document, and implement several best practice solutions, provide high-level critical data and systems integration and interoperability, Service Oriented Architecture (SOA/Metro Channel), and completion of email migration from Novell/GroupWise to Microsoft Outlook.

DESCRIPTION:

The Department of Information Technology (IT) does not have the skill set internally to identify, develop, and to complete the roll-out of SOA/Metro Channel and Microsoft Outlook. Consultant services are needed to acquire the knowledge and experience to analyze, design, document, and implement the plans to complete these projects. The consultants will enable IT to reduce liability and risk while supporting newer technologies and implementing industry-standard SOA and email infrastructures. This supports the Metro goal of using every resource wisely.

These requirements cover a total of six positions. They are contract positions expected to be extinguished as their projects are completed. Without the completion of these requirements, IT would need to maintain two distinct network management systems and the requisite staffing.
