The minutes of the October 10, 2024 Finance and Capital Committee meeting were approved as presented.

Information Item

A. Capital Program Update

Staff presented an overview of Metro's Capital Program, highlighting the history, funding constraints and future impacts of sustained underinvestment to State of Good Repair and ultimately service and reliability. Staff outlined the process for defining and prioritizing capital programs and highlighted efforts to reduce costs and maximize efficiencies. Staff provided a status review and outlook for the Zero-Emission Bus Transition and 8000-Series Railcar Program. Staff then discussed upcoming steps and addressed questions from board members.

B. FY2026 and FY2027 Operating Outlook

Staff presented an overview of the FY2026 and FY2027 Operating Outlook as it pertains to the FY2026 Proposed Budget. Staff discussed FY2026 budget drivers and potential service changes. Strong year-over-year ridership growth has allowed Metro to revise its FY2025 ridership assumptions. Staff also reviewed various strategies Metro is pursuing to advance cost savings. Staff outlined the current FY2026 operating deficit and strategies to mitigate the deficit. Staff then discussed areas nearing capacity, particularly at peak times, and four strategies to add peak capacity for growing ridership. Staff then discussed upcoming steps and addressed questions from board members.
