A. Acceptance of Public Communication and Outreach Report and Adoption of FY2019 Budget and FY2019-2024 CIP

Staff provided an overview of the Proposed FY2019 Operating Budget and FY2019-2024 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Staff noted that the budget is the same as the General Manager's Proposed Budget that was released in November, with the exception of \$500,000 in additional funding for the Office of the Inspector General, which would be offset by \$500,000 in additional management cost reductions.

Mr. McMillin moved, seconded by Mr. Evans, to forward to the Board for consideration the Public Communication and Outreach Report for the FY2019 Budget and FY2019-2024 CIP. This motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Dorsey moved, seconded by Mr. Corcoran, to forward to the Board for consideration the Proposed FY2019 Operating Budget and FY2019-2024 CIP. This motion was approved unanimously.
