DESCRIPTION:

Key Highlights:

Audit of WMATA's End-of-Service Life Operating System Software

Situation: WMATA has computers running operating system software that are no longer supported by the vendor. The end of vendor support has, in some cases, ended years earlier.

Impact: When vendors stop supporting older versions of their products, those products pose significant security risks because updates are no longer available.

These "known" vulnerabilities can be more easily exploited increasing the opportunities for cyberattack and data breaches.

Management Solution: Management is in the process of implementing our recommendations.

Background and History:

When the Executive Committee determines there is no conflict remaining between the IG's findings and recommendations and management's response, it will accept the report as final, and the report and corrective action plan shall be deemed approved. Acceptance of the final report constitutes the Board's authorization to post the report on the WMATA website provided the Inspector
