Recent Ridership Highlights:

- Bus and rail ridership **increased 20%** over April 2023
- **37 straight months** of combined average weekday year-over-year growth
- May 1: **Highest bus ridership** since 2020
- **100,000 customers** served via late-night bus network
- Mobile transactions **up 80%** in April 2024 from April 2023
- Fare evasion on Metrorail down over 60%



Historic Regional Collaboration

- First-ever joint Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments and WMATA Board of Directors Meeting
- Regional leadership to determine transportation vision for future
- One 20-person task force; Two working groups:
 - **Government Partners Advisory Group**
 - **Community Partners Advisory Group**
