WHEREAS, Compact Section 15 requires the Board of Directors to transmit proposed changes to the Mass Transit Plan to certain enumerated agencies and to conduct a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Arlington County has proposed to design, construct and turn-over to WMATA a new west entrance to the Ballston-MU Metro Station as part of its Transit Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, WMATA and Arlington County have conducted studies that showed demand exists for the additional entrance; and

WHEREAS, The addition of a new west entrance to the Ballston-MU Metro Station will result in a change to the Mass Transit Plan

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with Compact Section 15, the Board of Directors authorizes staff to transmit the proposed Mass Transit Plan changes to the enumerated agencies and to hold a public hearing on adding a new west entrance to the Ballston-MU Metro Station; and be it further


