
WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY Senior Vice President, Metro Integrated Command & Communications Center



The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (Metro) was created by an interstate compact in 1967 to plan, develop, build, finance, and operate a balanced regional transportation system in the national capital area. Metro began building its rail system in 1969, acquired four regional bus systems in 1973, and began operating the first phase of Metrorail in 1976. Today, Metrorail serves 97 stations and has 128 miles of track. Metrobus serves the nation's capital 24 hours a day, seven days a week with 1,500 buses. Metrorail and Metrobus serve a population of approximately 4 million within a 1,500-square mile jurisdiction. Metro began its paratransit service, MetroAccess, in 1994; it provides about 2.3 million trips per year.

The incumbent ensures safe and consistent management of rail and bus passenger service, movement and access on the Metrorail system, and rapid emergency response and effective communication to customers and employees. The incumbent understands and implements WMATA's guiding principles to best serve our customers and communities through ownership, transparency, inclusiveness, and collaborative management.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree in Transportation Management, Business Administration, Engineering, or related field.
- A minimum of twelve (12) years of experience in an operational environment (e.g., transit, aviation, military, law enforcement, etc.), to include at least five (5) years in a management capacity over staff, responsible for the safety of large groups of people.
