## New Metrobus Network Launching June 29, 2025

Bus routes are changing. Yes, even yours!



All routes will have new names



Some stops will be added, eliminated or moved



Some customers will need to transfer, while others will have new direct connections



Hours of operation on some routes will change



Some routes will come more or less frequently



Some customers will lose service, while others will gain service



We will need your help this spring and summer to help us spread the word about the changes, tools, and available support



## Timeline: Better Bus Network Redesign Launch

- Metro will be the first agency of its size to implement a full network redesign in one phase in under a year.
- Managing challenges to meet aggressive implementation plan and be ready on Launch Day
  - Utilizing temporary improvements to ensure customers and the workforce are ready on day-one
  - Implementing permanent solutions over the coming year

## Back-to-School Focus

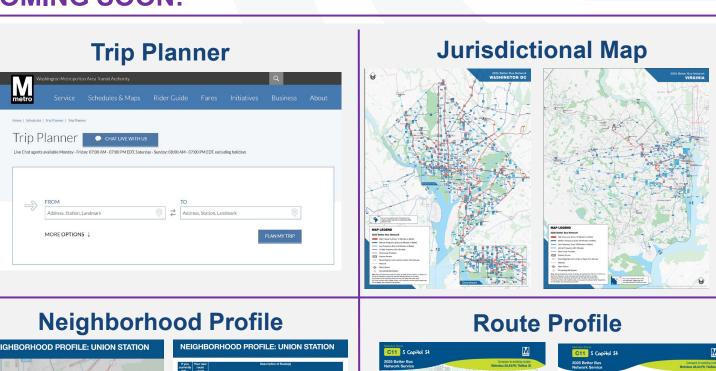
Purpose: Inform schools, parents, students about new routes

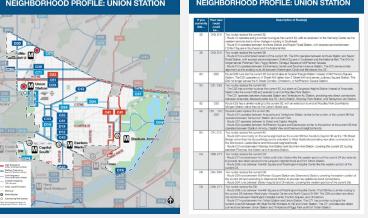
 Launch schoolfocused outreach for parents and students

# Public Outreach Materials

- Materials and information sharing will be executed using:
  - Metro Employees & Contractors (language services)
  - Metro Better Bus Stop Squads organizations and entities that will be the "eyes and ears" at designated bus stops
- Information will be shared at bus stops, community events, and other activity centers like farmers markets







## Key Updates: Signs and Maps



#### **BUS FLAGS**

Approximately 7,000 temporary bus flags

- Temporary Bus Flag design complete
- Installation: March 3rd May 25 (+/-)
- 8 crews installing ~200 Per Day
- As of March 29<sup>th</sup>, 1,700 flags installed in Virginia; DC starting next week





#### **MAPS AND MATERIALS**

Implementing New Network Specific Maps and Materials

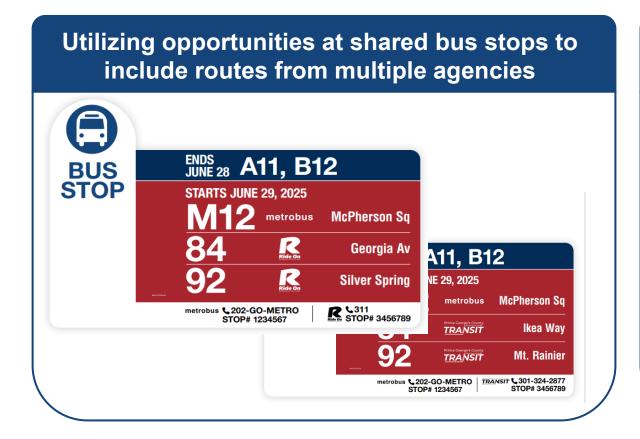
- Updating 106 unique maps, with 500+ to be installed
- Installation occurring after bus flags complete
- Bus Bay Station Maps & Jurisdiction Maps

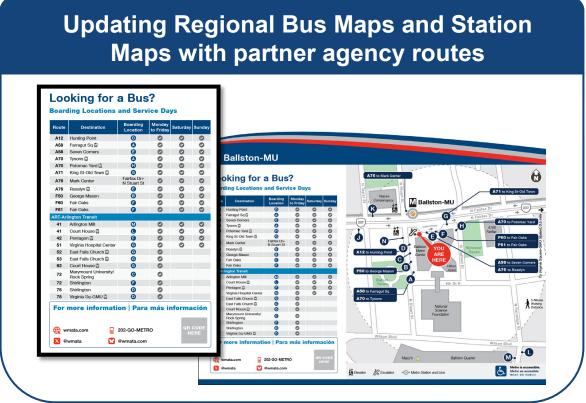




## Jurisdictional Coordination – Major Activities

- Working with each jurisdiction on bus stop and on-street improvements, noting that some improvements may not be implemented until after Launch Day
- Transferring buses to support Prince George's County Transit with service





## Key Updates: Internal Activities



#### **BUS PLANNING**

More efficient service using the same resources

- Improved route design and new scheduling strategies result in more time serving customers
- Increased fleet and operator productivity



#### **TRAINING**

Ensuring operations and communications staff trained on network

- Operator training underway with daily classes at each division
- 8,300 training shifts completed, covering 70 percent of anticipated training
- Metro Integrated Command and Communications Center (MICC) and Call Center training underway



#### **DIGITAL SYSTEMS**

Updating internal and external systems to support new network

- Updating audio, destination signs, real-time data (BusETA, Pulse, API)
- Integrating HASTUS and Trapeze Daily Ops so that timekeeping, bus assignment, and other systems are ready for Launch Day



### **Next Steps**

- Finalizing trip planner, maps, and profiles
- Continuing bus stop flag installation
- Identifying outreach events and pop-up locations and dates
- Finalizing advertising and media activities
- Better Bus Improvements Beyond Launch Day
  - Back to School Outreach Effort (Summer 2025)
  - Bus Stop and On-Street Improvements (Ongoing)
  - Permanent Bus Flags and Maps
