Purple Line Construction

Mezzanine construction and tie-in work at Silver Spring

Safety & Infrastructure Upgrades

- Fiber cable installation for communication improvement
- Rail infrastructure upgrades: interlocking upgrades, switch machine replacements, tie and rail renewal, and grout pad replacements
- Drainage pump system and standpipe upgrades
- Power and electrical upgrades
- Tunnel and platform light upgrades
- Tunnel leak mitigation

Customer Experience Improvements

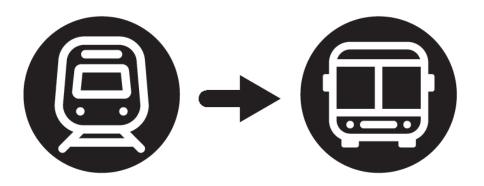
- New digital screens, PIDs, and wall information screens

Impacted Stations

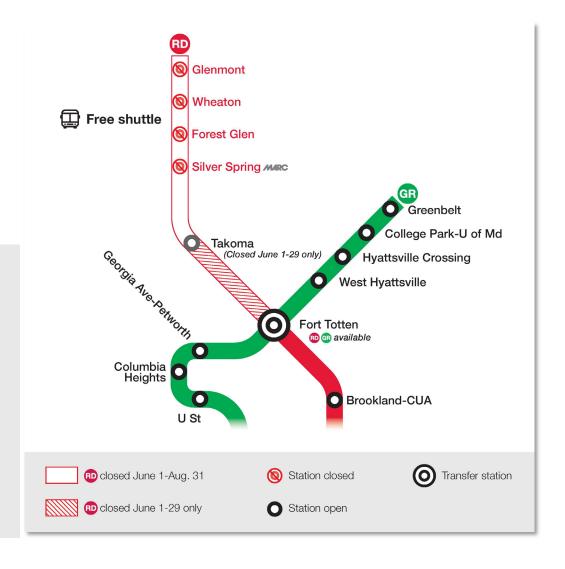


June 1-Aug. 31

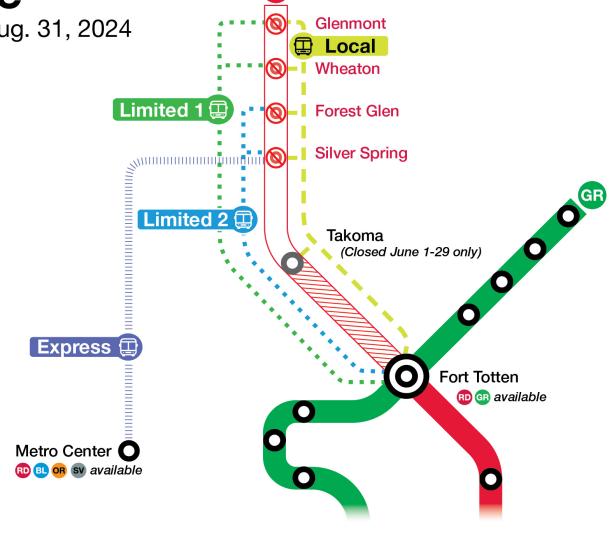

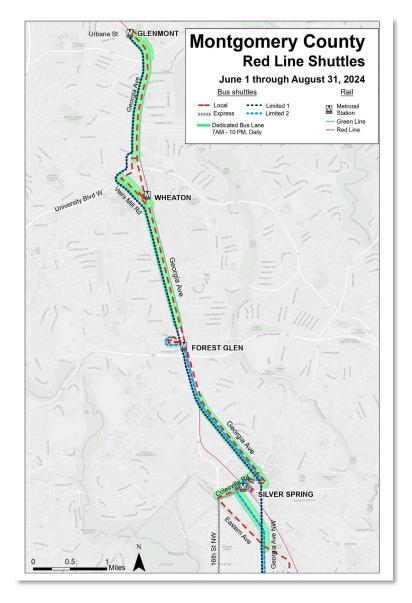


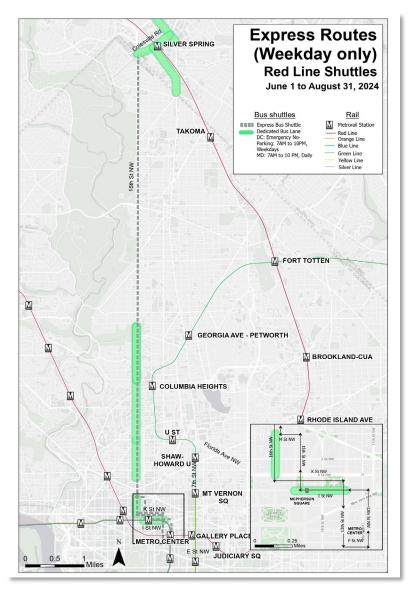

Pre-closures playbook

Objectives: Build customer awareness of travel alternatives; enhance understanding and trust that the work is necessary

Jan-March 2024 Initial Awareness

- Media relations
 (overview of work, why it's necessary, shuttle options)
- Government relations briefings
- Communications planning

April 2024 Travel Alternatives

- Webpage launch (travel alternatives, communications toolkit, e-newsletter sign-up)
- Communications toolkit (ready-to go newsletter text, social media posts, shuttle maps, graphics)

May 2024 Partner Outreach
