Metro Transit Police Department (MTPD) Investigations Review Panel reviewed six (6) 2023 Q1 cases, and respectfully submit the following findings and recommendations:

## 1. Excessive Use of Force

- a. Background MTPD Officer used excessive force against complainant. Determine if the Officer's actions were commensurate with the policies and procedures of MTPD.
- b. Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statements and also the video of the incident was available.
- c. Recommendations:
  - The Review Panel agreed with the investigation and no further recommendations were made at the time of the review.
- Rude, Discourteous or Inappropriate Comments/Behavior or Gestures
  - a. Background MTPD Officer photo posted on Twitter checking on unhoused (homeless) individual sleeping near the escalators.
  - Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statements and agreed with the investigation's findings of insufficient evidence to disprove the allegations.
  - c. Recommendations:
    - i. None
- 3. Failure to take Necessary Police action while on-duty, Rude and Discourteous
  - a. Background MTPD Officer responded to an assault call and failed to conduct a proper preliminary investigation, which resulted in him completing a report which did not accurately reflect the incident.
  - b. Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statements and also watched the video of the incident. The MTPD Officer's report did accurately depict the incident that occurred. The Review Panel agreed with the investigator's findings.
  - c. Recommendations:
    - i. None

- 4. Notification of a Telephone call complaint from Mother of the arrested citizen, discourteous and rude behavior by Officer
  - a. Background MTPD Officer used profanity, rude, discourteous and inappropriate behavior and excessive force when arresting the individual involved in a chaotic scene at the Anacostia Metro Station.
  - b. Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statements and also viewed the video footage of the scene at the Metro Station. The Review Panel agreed with the investigation's findings. The cameras used by the MTPD clearly helps the Review Panel in making a clear assessment of the actions of the Officers and the citizen's being filmed in these settings.
  - c. Recommendations:
    - i. None
- 5. Supervisory Violation: Failure to Report to Scene When Required
  - a. Background Response to a bomb threat at L'Enfant Plaza Metro which led to a station's evacuation.
  - Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statements and fully agreed with the investigation's findings.
  - c. Recommendations:
    - i. None
- 6. Conflict of Interest Involving Off-Duty Conduct
  - a. Background Recruit Officer involved in an off-duty car accident and left the scene.
  - Findings The Review Panel reviewed the statement and fully agreed with the investigation's findings.
  - c. Recommendations:

None
