Question 1: If a prime DBE must meet the 11% goal with another DBE, does that DBE have to be certified with WMATA or could they be a certified DBE through other agencies such as MDOT, Prince George's County, etc.)?

ANSWER: They must be certified by WMATA or our certified partners DDOT, no other certifications will be acceptable. DDOT is DC Department of Transportation.

Question 2: If a vendor is a WMATA-certified DBE submitting as a prime, must that vendor still meet the 11% DBE requirements with another DBE or will the DBE prime qualify as having met the goal itself??

ANSWER: If the Prime is a DBE the goal is met as long as they self-perform the work. In other words they cannot sub out work. They must do at least 30 percent of the work with their own forces.

Question 3: Is there a bid bond for this initiative? If so, how much is it?

ANSWER: The RFP does not require a bid bond.
