Answers to questions are as follows:

General Questions:

1. Is WMATA committed to a rental industrial laundry service or is the Authority amenable to other managed services, if significant benefits such as cost savings, superior PPE offerings, etc., could be measured?

Answer- WMATA will award one (1) contract to the lowest responsive responsible "Bidder" using an Invitation for Bid (IFB) format. Bidders' are hereby informed that the IFB format method does not allow for any discussions during evualation of Bids. Therefore, Bidder's response must exhibit that their Company can successfully comply with provisions and preform all requirements listed in IFB CQ6063/DYB: This includes supplying Rental Wear (Apparel & Accessories) and providing industrial laundry services for rented Apparel.

Bidder(s) must demonstrate though their "Bid Response their Company can fulfill subsequent contract requirements.

2. Does The Authority currently utilize an industrial laundry service for the ARC Flash safety garments/kits? If so, who is the provider?

Answer- No the Authority does not currently utilize an industrial laundry service for ARC Flash Safety garments/kits.

Scope of Work Questions:

3. On page 70, it states "Contractor will provide electrical rated anti-fog face shields with hard hats and chin guards.... Does this refer to the 40 and 65 cal hoods? Typically, this feature is not required for 40 and 65 cal hoods. This feature is normally found with ARC Flash head protection 20 cal/cm2 and less.

Answer- This does not refer to the 40 and 65 cal hoods.

4. The solicitation requests Multi-Layer "Kevlar/Nomex" fabrics. Will functionally alternative fabrics that meet all the OSHA standards outlined in solicitation be accepted?

Answer- Bidders are advised that a specific brand is identified in the technical specifications. It does not restrict Bidders to the specified manufacturer's brand name. Brand specified is only used to identify quality and performance desired (*See* Solicitation Instruction Article 29- Brand Name or Equal of the IFB CQ16063/DYB).

If Bidder is offering a manufacturer other than what is identified in the Specifications, then descriptive literature must be included with pricing data. WMATA will use this literature to verify conformance to industry requirements.

5. What is the brand and part numbers currently being used for the 40 and 65 cal suits?

Answer-40cal suits are Chicago Apparel part No. AWG44, WMATA has not ordered any 65 cal suits to date

Pre-Qualification Requirements

6. On Page 23, Section 8, there is a reference to SCHEDULE TWO, which states to include "two contracts that are similar in scope and discipline as requirements herewith." May we include two existing garment contracts (one FR) currently awarded to Safeware by Metro

Answer- Bidders' are advised that to be eligible for Award consideration, Firm must demonstrate Experience and Capability to successfully fulfill and maintain Contract requirements. As a part of Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. CQ16063, Bidder's must complete and return the Pre- Award Evaluation Section and include contracts that are "similar in scope and discipline as said requirements: Bidders Pre Award information will be used to verify "Company" ability/capability to meet and maintain Contract requirements.
