# WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY SUPPLY AND SERVICE CONTRACT RFP-CQ18002/BTK

 The Contractor is responsible for picking up the vehicles and equipment from the WMATA locations at the end of the rental period.

### Pricing and Technical Proposals Evaluation Criteria:

Proposals will be evaluated based upon application of the following Evaluation Criteria:

#### e. Price

There <u>must be no hidden costs</u> in the lease agreement. All leases must include unlimited mileage. All fees should be clearly stated in the pricing proposal.

Maintenance and repair costs for the trucks and equipment for the duration of the lease must be included in the pricing proposal. In case the trucks or equipment malfunction or need repair, the Contractor will be responsible for all of the repairs, including replacement parts at no additional cost to the Authority. Pick-up and delivery charges shall be included in the price proposal.

# f. Trucks and Equipment Specifications

Offers must submit the manufacturer's truck and equipment specifications, (Appendix A and B) with their technical proposals to show that they comply with Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's (WMATA) truck and equipment specifications. Offerors must check the box in column "B" if their proposal meets the WMATA's specifications. Offerors' proposals will not be considered as meeting WMATA's specification requirements if box "B" is not checked.

## g. Lease Agreement/Terms

A proposed form of a Lease Agreement <u>must be submitted</u> with pricing and technical proposals. Lease terms and conditions are subject to further negotiation with WMATA.

#### h. Past Performance

Offerors must have experience on projects of the same or similar nature and degree of complexity as the proposed project. Offerors must demonstrate experience in being responsive to the Authority's needs as in the statement of work (SOW), including pick- up and delivery and maintenance and repair. Please provide three (3) references for evaluation who will confirm offeror's ability to perform. References should include the following: Company name, mailing address, telephone number and email address of contact.

#### Performance Schedules

- The vehicles and equipment must be on WMATA's property by November 1, 2017 and remain on WMATA's property through March 31, 2018.
- Payments shall be invoiced in five (5) monthly payments and billed each month of the rental term.
