Please be advised that because this solicitation is an IFB, any qualifying statements, alterations, or exceptions taken to any section of the IFB submitted with the bid package may result in determination that the bid is non-responsive and rejection of the entire bid package, thus making it ineligible for award. Also, failure to submit any requirements of the IFB may cause your bid to be determined non-responsive and rejected, and thus ineligible for award.
