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QUESTIONS FROM INTERESTED VENDORS AND WMATA RESPONSES

1. Q: Are these frogs all 115RE?
R: Yes
2. Q: We are having difficulty reading some of the data on the drawings. Is it possible to obtain better quality drawings?
R: If there are specific drawings that need clarification, please provide. Since the majority of the drawings have been scanned several years ago, clearer drawings are not available.
3. Q: Do you want plates with any of the frogs? Please identify what else is required (if anything) with the frogs. Plates and elastomeric pads are shown on the BOMS on some drawings. As information the welded boltless frogs you are requesting are necessarily shorter than old standard RBM frogs so some original shoulders at the heel end may not contact the frog.
R: WMATA is only procuring **rail bound manganese steel frogs** under this contract, which must meet current AREMA design. There should not be an issue with shoulders not contacting the frog.
4. Q: On the Bid/Price Schedule, which angle is for Item #3 No. 8 Diamond End Frog 40'6" TC?
R: The correct angle is 24°02'22". Please delete the Bid/Price Schedule and replace it with the attached Bid/Price Schedule Rev.1.
5. Q: Items #7-10 on the Bid/Price Schedule show an angle of 19°46'10", but the drawing ST-TW-082 shows an angle of 19°48'40". Which is correct?
R: 19°48'40" is correct. Please delete the Bid/Price Schedule and replace it with the attached Bid/Price Schedule Rev.1.
6. Q: What is the X-ray requirement for castings? Industry standard is 1 in 5,10,20 per pattern. Do all castings require X-ray or is industry standard acceptable?
R: AREMA Section M2.5 provides guidance for radiographic testing of the frog castings as specified in the SOW. Testing of frog castings for this contract shall be 1 in the first 5 produced, and 1 out of every 10 produced thereafter per pattern.
