Contractor Questions and WMATA Answers
December 4, 2015

1. Q: Are there exclusive franchise agreements that exist in the relevant municipalities which would limit revenue sources to WMATA? If so, who holds them?

A: There are no existing telecommunications franchise agreements with any of the local jurisdictions

2. Q: Does WMATA have any candidates in mind to whom it would be interested in leasing capacity or space?

A: No. Proposers are required to identify candidates that would be interested in leasing capacity or space.

3. Q: How many entities are currently using existing rights of way with permission?

A: There are currently 13 telecommunications firms authorized to use the rights-of-way.

4. Q: Are, or will, rights of way be available across the WMATA network?

A: Yes-new users will be able to obtain contracts for WMATA rights-of-way. Under their current contracts, existing users can extend beyond the track area to other WMATA property.

5. Q: In reference to electronically submitted proposals, would PDF binders that are password protected be acceptable?

A: Yes, as long as WMATA can access all proposal information submitted by the contractor.

6. Q: Can tasks be priced based on a separate methodology? For example, a percentage base and/or fee based?

A: Proposers must propose a percentage-of-revenue price in their response using the Revenue/Percentage Schedule Sheet included in this RFP.
