## **Expression of Interest - 8000 Series Railcars**

The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) is in the planning stage for its next railcar procurement. This procurement could be for replacement of 2000 and 3000 Series cars. These new cars will be designated as the 8000 Series. While the 8000 series cars will take a technological leap relative to earlier series, the 8000 Series cars still represent an evolution from the 7000 Series cars currently being procured. In advance of preparing a complete technical specification, WMATA is requesting comments from the railcar industry regarding significant changes that might be incorporated into the 8000 Series cars. The attached document (General Design Criteria for Industry Comment) identifies 17 areas of change and asks questions regarding each. WMATA appreciates any response that you may provide.
