Question from contractor: In our experience, construction projects containing federal funding must include requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act. This assures local contractors a fair opportunity to compete for local federal contracts. This request for proposal is to supply and install communications system components at various locations including devices, equipment, conduit, cable and testing. As written, the RFP allows the bidding contractor to pay workers less than the local prevailing wage and thus creates an unfair bidding environment for union contractors. We request WMATA re-visit application of the Davis-Bacon Act to this RFP.						
Answer: WMATA intends to award a Supplies and Services contract, not a construction contract.
