## **Solicitation Notice - IFB No.: FQ18166 Heat inductor System Q&A Round 2 5/11/18**

1. What are the required temperatures – required production rates or cycle times – exact grade or type of material?
  - a. The materials for both of the ground rings (1 being bronze and the other being Stainless steel)
  - b. We need regulated and controlled temperatures from between 300 degrees Fahrenheit to up to 700 degrees Fahrenheit. WE will be using the unit once every hour during an 8 hour period to remove the ground ring from the axle.
  - c. The Axle material that these ground rings are both seated on to and removed from is 4130, 4150, and 5150 forged grade "H" steel.
