CQ17034 - Answers to Questions for VmWare ELA Maintenance & Support

1. Question: The document mentions a 5% small business and local preference goal per solicitation can you please let me know what this means?

2. Question: Is this a 5% small business requirement or simply a preference in evaluation?

Answer: If the proposer is not an SBLPP, the proposer agrees that the SBLPP goal for this Contract shall be met by SBLPP subcontractors or by joint ventures with SBLPPs. The goal set forth for this Contract is 5% of the final Contract price, including amendment and modification. The amount of SBLPP participation will be determined by the dollar value of the work performed and/or supplies furnished by SBLPP firms as compared to the total value of all work performed and/or supplies furnished under this Contract. The Contractor shall have met this goal if the Contractor's SBLPP participation meets or exceeds this goal. Please review Appendix C. Also there is a listing of SBLPP certified firms can be found on wmata.com, click on Business with METRO, and follow the link to Small Business & Local Preference Program.

Please note: The 5% goal has been removed.

3. Question: Can you please clarify the price schedule on page 3 of the Document what does the line item from 1 to 3 refers to? Also the refers to page 22 and I don't see price schedule (See continuation of Schedule on page 22)

Answer: The price schedule is for the total price for the Base Year, Option Year 1 and Option Year 2. Please disregard the referral to page 22 (It should read pages 4 thru 6).

4. Question: Also are you looking for pricing for year 2 and year 3 on annual bases or will this be a purchase of either 1 years 2 years or 3 years upfront?

Answer: The contract award will be the entire three years. A purchase order will be issued at the onset of each year.

5. Question: Will it be acceptable to include only annual cost for base year 1, base year 2 and base year 3? In this case no individual license/line item pricing would be provided, a table will however be included to show the license descriptions and quantities included in the annual cost for each base year. Will this be ok?

Answer: VmWare has agreed to provide the information per line item for WMATA.
