



Economic Inclusion Program

- Goal: 30% participation from businesses with certification from Federal and regional entities of total project costs
- Definition of certified businesses:
 - Not size restricted (i.e. not necessarily a "DBE", per WMATA's definition)
 - Recognize Federal certifications issued by U.S. Small Business Administration and U.S. DOT
 - Recognize District of Columbia, State of Maryland, and State of Virginia certifications
 - Recognize vendors in Washington Metropolitan Unified Certification Program
