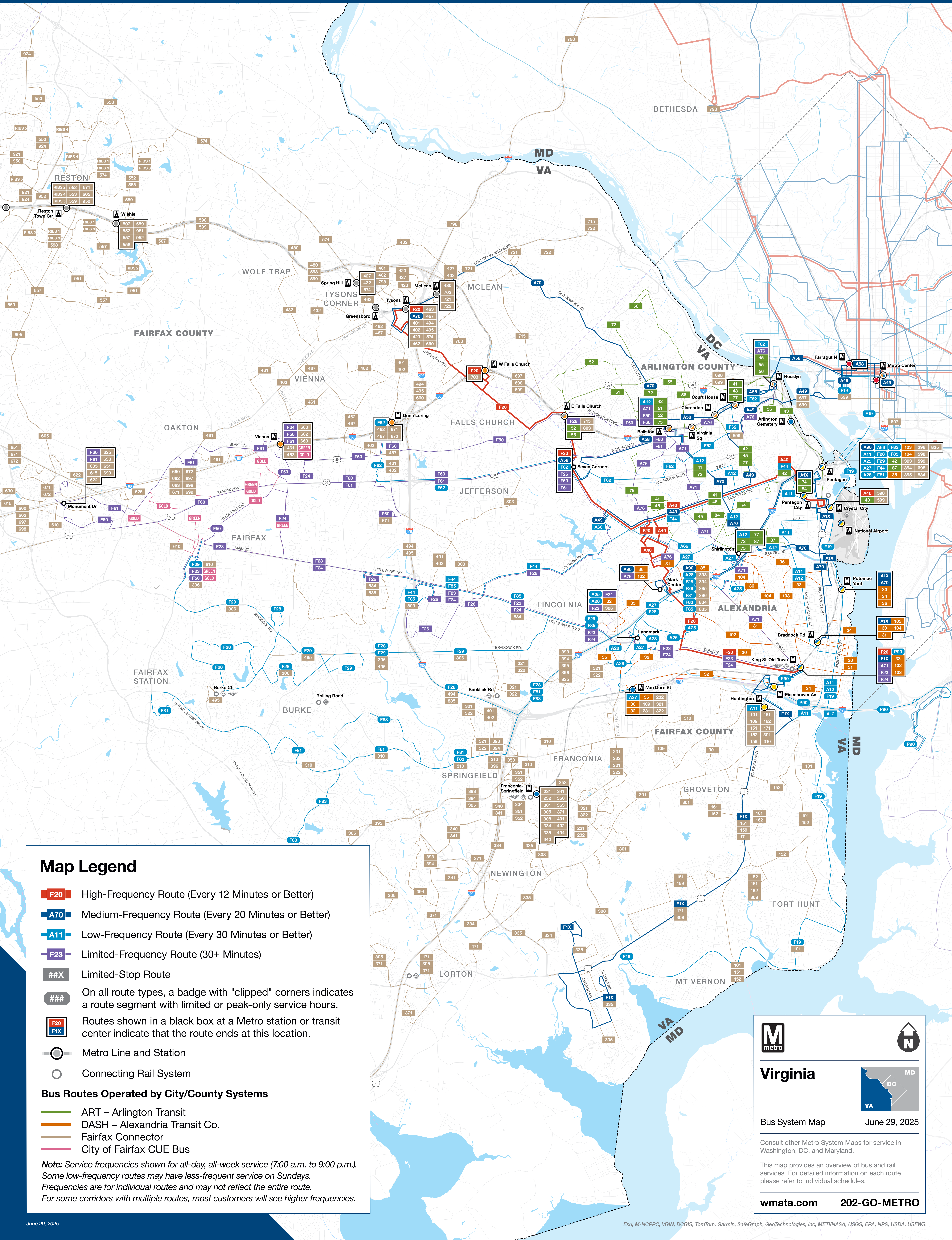




Metrobus and Connecting Bus Service in Virginia

- Connecting Rail System

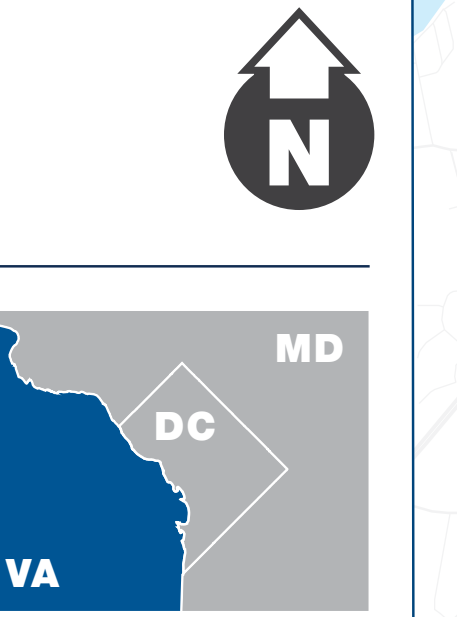
