- All sworn members issued a Conducted Electronic Weapon (CEW/Taser) are required to complete sixteen (16) hours of training to obtain initial certification, followed by annual refresher training. This instruction includes a review of departmental policies governing the safe use of the device, as well as practical exercises designed to reinforce proper deployment and operational procedures.
- MTPD is committed to providing its members with access to resources that offer assistance when needed while preserving confidentiality. Accordingly, referrals to the Employee Assistance Program (EAP) may be documented in the Report of Investigation, when appropriate.
