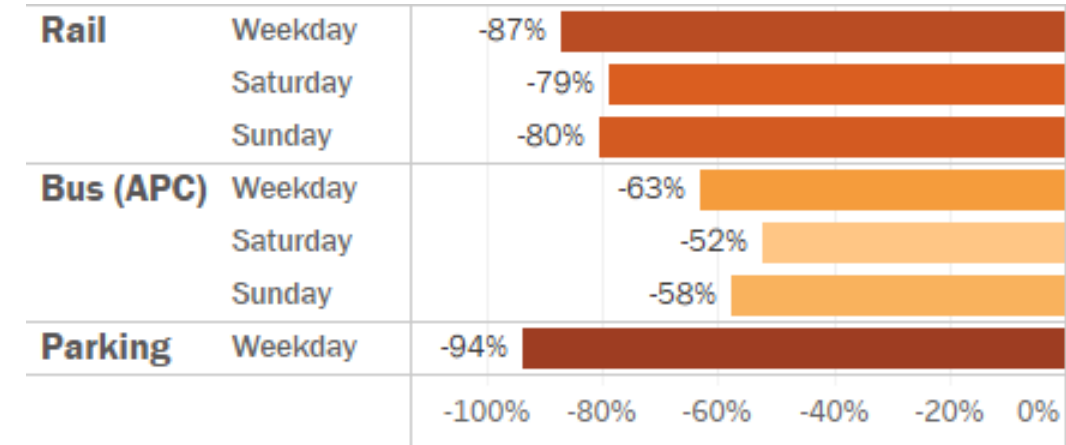

Overall Ridership in February

- Continuing impacts from COVID-19
- Rail
 - Ridership 87% lower than 2020 on weekdays
- Bus
 - Ridership 63% lower than 2020 on weekdays
 - Fare collection and front-door boarding
 - *Automatic Passenger Counter ridership data shown here*
- Parking
 - Usage 94% lower than 2020

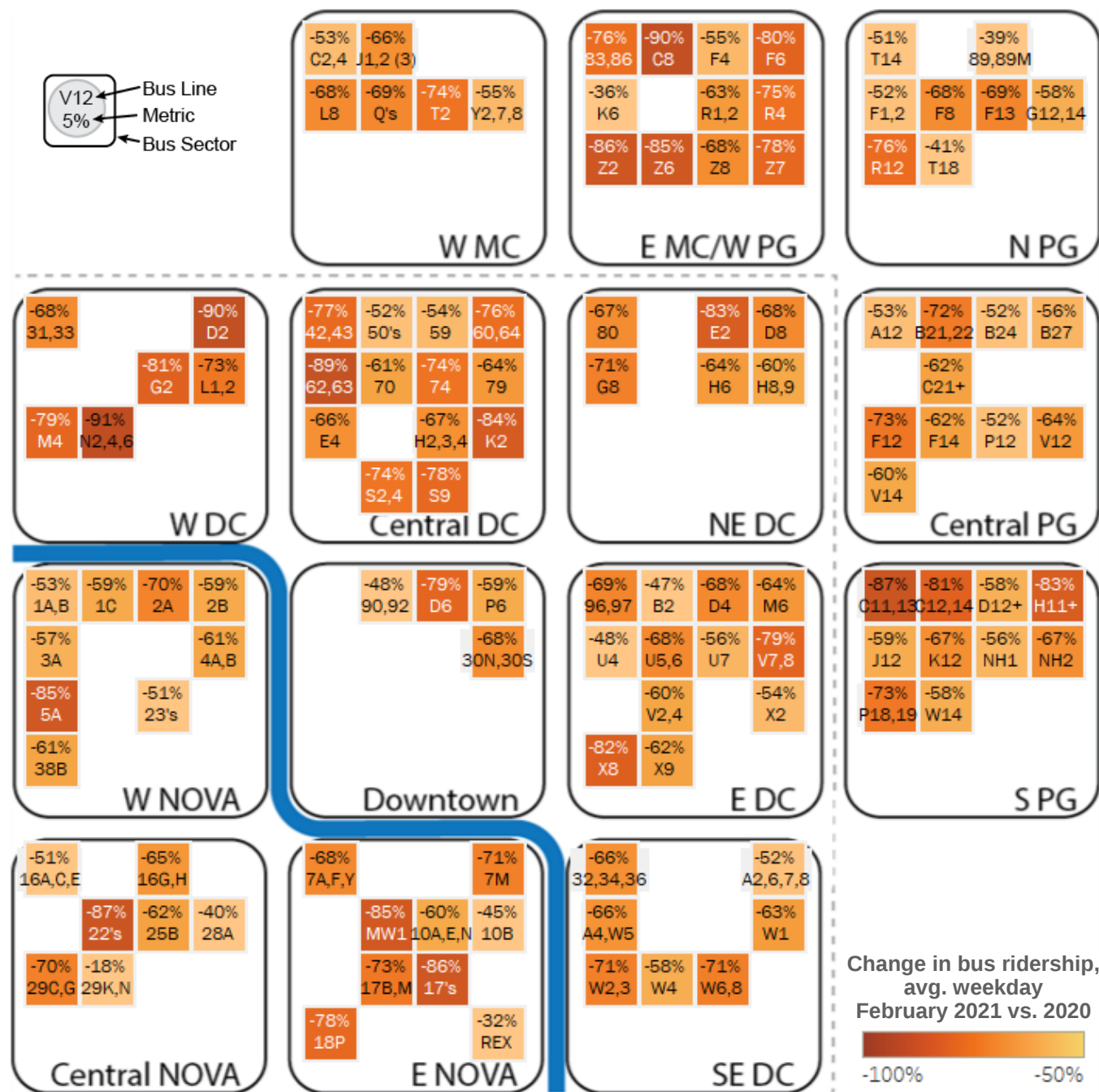


Metrobus Ridership

- Weekday ridership 63% lower than 2020 levels

- Notes:

- Bus service around 75% of pre-COVID levels. Some routes suspended.
- Moderate and severe weather impacted service on several days (Mon 2/1; Tue 2/2; Sun 2/7; Sat 2/13; Sun 2/14; Thu 2/18 and Fri 2/19)



Metro Parking Utilization

- Paid parking 94% lower than last year
