Metro's Art in Transit partnered with the Rosslyn Business Improvement District (BID) to beautify the construction barricades at the Rosslyn Metro station. The Rosslyn BID worked with the Museum of Contemporary Art Arlington and the Arlington Artists Alliance to invite artists to submit artwork proposals for the barricades.
