Changes are coming to Metro this Summer!

Metrorail Changes effective Sunday, June 22, 2025

New Metrorail services will launch on Sunday, June 22. The Board-approved FY-2026 rail service changes will take effect on this date, except for the extension of every other Yellow Line train to Greenbelt, which will begin in December 2025.

Rail changes taking effect include:

- Expanded weekend service hours: The rail system will close one hour later Friday and Saturday nights, at 2 a.m., and open one hour earlier on Saturday and Sunday mornings, at 6 a.m.
- Sending every other Silver Line train to New Carrollton instead of Downtown Largo
- Additional Red and Silver Line service in the peak of weekday rush hours
- Shorter rail running times for Automatic Train Operation system wide
