

# OR 2023 Major Construction

Effective: June 26 – July 16, 2023

## Project Overview

Metro's 2023 Major Construction is a four-part construction project focused on maintenance and rail technology upgrades. These improvements will modernize the Metro system and increase reliability for customers.

The project is happening in several phases:

- May 12 – 21** Waterproofing station roofs along the eastern **OR** in Maryland
- June 3 – 25** Replacing rail and installing fiber optic cables on the western **OR** and **SV** in Virginia
- July 22 – Sept. 4** Installing fiber optic cables on the northern **GR** in Maryland

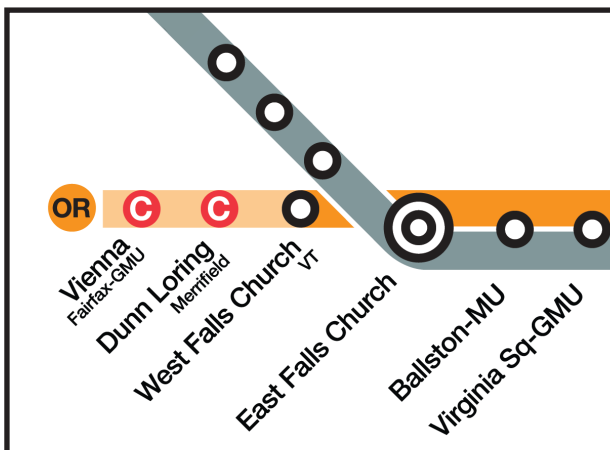
Key **OR** **SV** dates:

- June 3 - Vienna, Dunn Loring, West Falls Church, and East Falls Church close for construction.
- June 25 - East Falls Church and West Falls Church reopen.
- July 16 - Vienna and Dunn Loring reopen.

No **OR** between Vienna and West Falls Church

Daytime and weekends (6 – 9 a.m., 3 – 7 p.m.)

- **OR** trains every 12 minutes each between West Falls Church and New Carrollton

Late Night (after 9:30 p.m.)

- **OR** trains every 15 minutes between West Falls Church and New Carrollton

In the downtown core area, customers will continue to find frequent service at stations served by multiple lines.

- Vienna and Dunn Loring (June 3 – July 16)

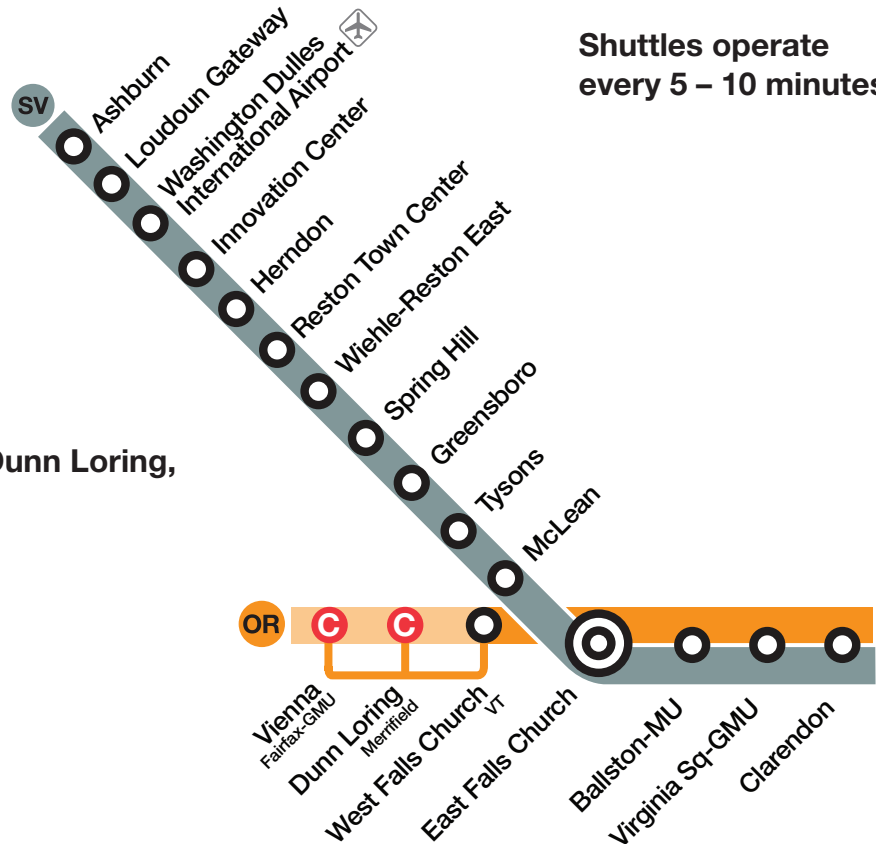
## Travel Alternatives
