#### The project is happening in several phases:

▼ May 12 – 21 Waterproofing station roofs along the eastern on in Maryland

√ June 3 – 25 Replacing rail and installing fiber optic cables on the western on and sv in Virginia

√ June 26 – July 16 Continued rail replacement and installing fiber optic cables on the western on in Virginia.

July 22 - Sept. 4 Installing fiber optic cables on the northern in Maryland
