We're taking your input seriously—stay tuned for updates to the draft Visionary Network based on what you told us!

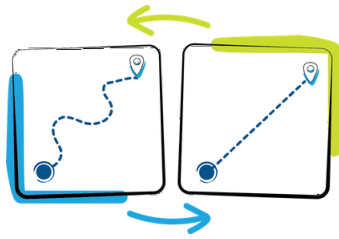
