WHAT'S CHANGING?

Bus Route Names

All of Metro's bus routes will have new names.

Schedules and Routes

Some of Metro's bus routes will run at different times or serve new areas. Many routes will have improved frequencies.

Bus Stops

Most of Metro's bus stops will remain the same, some will be added, and a small number will be removed to speed up service.



Metro's Trip Planner provides the information you need to get where you need to go. It can now also show you what your trips will look like with the new bus network.

WHAT IS METRO DOING TO PREPARE?

Customer and Community Engagement

Offering opportunities to help customers understand how their bus service is changing.

Promotions and Advertising

Spreading the word through print and digital materials at bus stops, on buses, in Metro stations, and in the community.

Operations and Logistics

Updating bus stop signs, training our bus operators and Customer Service staff, and coordinating with regional partners.

The goals of Metro's new bus network are to provide more frequent, consistent bus service, enhance access across the region, and make bus service easier to understand, all while using the resources we have today. The network was approved by Metro's Board of Directors in November 2024.

These changes affect Metro's bus service across the region. Metro is collaborating with other providers to ensure seamless transfers between systems.

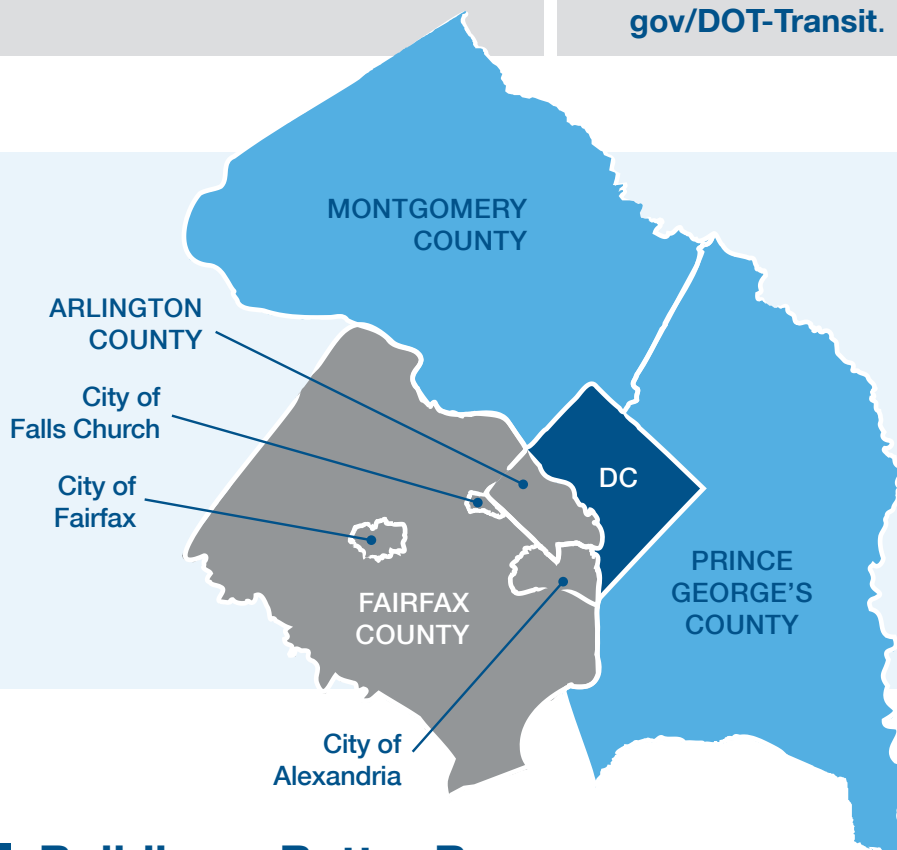
All Metro routes in Washington, DC, Maryland, and Virginia are changing.

Since Metro started the Network Redesign project in 2022, community feedback directly influenced the development of the new bus network. Through a two-year planning process that included nearly six months of public engagement, Metro received more than 33,000 comments from customers. This feedback was carefully considered in developing the new bus network.
