Farebox Installation **Project**

FACT SHEET

Beginning this winter, we will be installing brand-new fareboxes on Metrobus. This technology investment means improved reliability and faster processing of transactions, all leading to a better bus experience for you!

It is expected to take approximately one year to update our more than 1,600 bus fleet and to upgrade the fare technology at our 10 bus garages.

Modernized Convenience

What to Expect

While the new fareboxes will operate similarly to the current ones, some things may look a little different.

New, improved, and coming soon

- The SmarTrip card reader, currently located inside the farebox, will be moved to a separate location near the farebox. This will allow for easier maintenance and less disruption to service
- The SmarTrip card readers on Metrobus will be the same model as the ones on our newly installed faregates, a first in Metro's history

Same convenient access you have today

- Bills, coins, and approved tokens will continue to be accepted at the farebox
- You'll still have the option to pay using your SmarTrip card or Mobile wallet
- Check your balance and add value (cash-to-card) at the reader

To minimize impacts to your commute, installations will take place only on buses that are out of service.
