- WMATA revised its procedure to clarify the quality control follow-up requirements, and issued a procedure to clarify supervisors' quality control requirements and how to document quality control observations in its asset management system.
- VMMATA identified the supervisors who are required to conduct two quality control audits, and modified performance plans for the supervisors to include audits and audit documentation in its asset management system.
- WMATA generated monthly reports that track the audits conducted by each supervisor, and provided their management with a copy of the report.
- WMATA generated a quarterly asset management system audit compliance report to verify compliance; and provided the report to appropriate levels of management.
- Finally, WMATA performed a quality verification of actionable items.
