Expansion of Late-night Bus Service

Starting the week of June 6, 2021, service will extend until 2 a.m., 7 days a week, on the following routes:

DC 32, 33, 36, 38B, 52, 70, 80, 92, A6, A8, G8, H4, L2, P6, S2, U5, V2, W2, W4, X2

MD A12, C4, D12, F4, J2, K6, P12, T18, Y2, Z8

VA 1A, 7A, 10A, 16E, 23B, 28A, 38B
