RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors hereby reappoints Roger Stanley and appoints Will Schell to the AAC representing the State of Maryland to a term of July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2020, or until replacement identified by the Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors hereby reappoints Doris Ray to the AAC representing the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Access for All Committee to a term of July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2020, or until replacement identified by the Board; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That to ensure no lapse in committee memberships, this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
