The Committee met with the leadership of both the Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) and Riders' Advisory Council (RAC), using the RAC's proposed 2016 Work Plan as a starting point to discuss items of interest to both groups. Topics included options to reduce crowding on the Blue Line; the issue that locked gates, particularly at Pentagon City and Gallery Place Metrorail stations present a safety concern; and the continued need to include the disability community in emergency drills. Opportunities for both groups to partner in their work were also discussed, such as in collecting rider feedback on the 7000 series rail cars, identifying ideas to restore access to bus stops more quickly after snowstorms, and having meetings between AAC members, RAC members, and their corresponding jurisdictional Board members.
